Proposed Recommendation:	<p>The Sustainability Committee has reviewed the draft of Ho'omauō Kapi'olani: The Kapi'olani Community College Sustainability & Climate Action Plan (1/25/17 draft, Chancellor's Advisory Council) and solicited feedback from our respective departments.</p> <p>We request that the Faculty Senate submit a request to the Chancellor's Advisory Council (CAC) to add an executive summary to the draft Ho'omauō Kapi'olani: The Kapi'olani Community College Sustainability & Climate Action Plan that outlines the roles and responsibilities of the various parties on campus. Specifically, that the summary should include a few sentences directed towards faculty participation requirements while also encouraging the incorporation of sustainability into the classroom and raising the profile of these pursuits for faculty.</p>

	<p>We recommend that in the plan sections related to faculty that the plan language be reviewed and revised to clarify that incorporating sustainability into curriculum is voluntary and will be supported by the Faculty Senate Sustainability Committee. We also recommend that the CAC address plan implementation, including costs, and how faculty will be supported in sustainability initiatives.</p> <p>We also request that the FS Sustainability Committee be given an opportunity to review future drafts prior to distribution to the campus departments.</p>
