Please describe the action requested:	Effective Fall 2016, MATH 24 and MATH 25 will no longer be offered. There are three pathways in the Developmental Math Acceleration Model. Faculty, who have these courses as a prerequisite and as a recommended preparation, must decide on the pathway that provides the essential math skills needed for success in the course. These courses must be updated by the faculty in Curriculum Central as courses are the purview of the faculty. This action request is to seek approval from Faculty Senate for Academic Affairs to take care of changing the prerequisites/recommended preparation in Banner and in the 2016-2017 catalog to lessen the work that should be done by the faculty to make the changes in Curriculum Central and the work of the Curriculum Committee members. In order for Academic Affairs to make the changes, faculty will need to submit their decision on which new course will replace the

	current prerequisite/recommended prep.
Proposed Recommendation:	Approval for Academic Affairs to make changes in the prerequisite/ recommended preparation in Banner and the 2016 - 2017 catalog after receipt of faculty decision of replacement class.
