Subject: Resolution regarding Amendment to Bylaws re: Unrepresented Faculty

I support the Faculty Senate's May 1, 2017, resolution to temporarily amend the Faculty Senate bylaws to allow for the representation of faculty not affiliated with any of the units listed in the approved bylaws. I understand that this temporary amendment will expire May 2018 "if no permanent solution is found."

I would encourage the Faculty Senate to work towards a permanent solution. Given the recommendations proposed in various draft campus plans, I see more faculty being assigned to provide institutional support and in need of Senate representation. A re-examination of current approved units may also be warranted, prompted by the description of the faculty covered by this amendment in Michelle Sturges' April 17, 2017, memo: "faculty who are part of the Combined Departments for Personnel Review (CDPR) but who are not a part of either the Office of Continuing Education and Training (OCET) or the Honda International Center (HIC)."
