Please describe the action requested:	<p>On page A-41 of the KCC 2014-2015 Catalog, the Scholastic Standards section states:</p> <p>"To be considered in good standing and to be eligible for a degree or certificate, students must maintain a cumulative grade point ratio (GPR) of 2.0 ("C") or higher. See the additional academic requirements for individual programs."</p> <p>Currently, in many of the awards and certificate grids in the catalog, there is no mention of a required institutional cumulative grade point ratio. Many of the them state:</p> <p>"The issuance of a [degree or certificate] requires that the student must earn a grade point ratio (GPR) of 2.0 or higher for all courses applicable toward the degree."</p> <p>This committee has discussed the past cases where students meet the degree/certificate requirement but not the institutional cumulative grade point ratio requirement.</p>

Proposed Recommendation:	This committee requests that in each program grid of the catalog the following language be added in addition to the program requirements: "See institutional policies on awarding of degrees and certificates."
